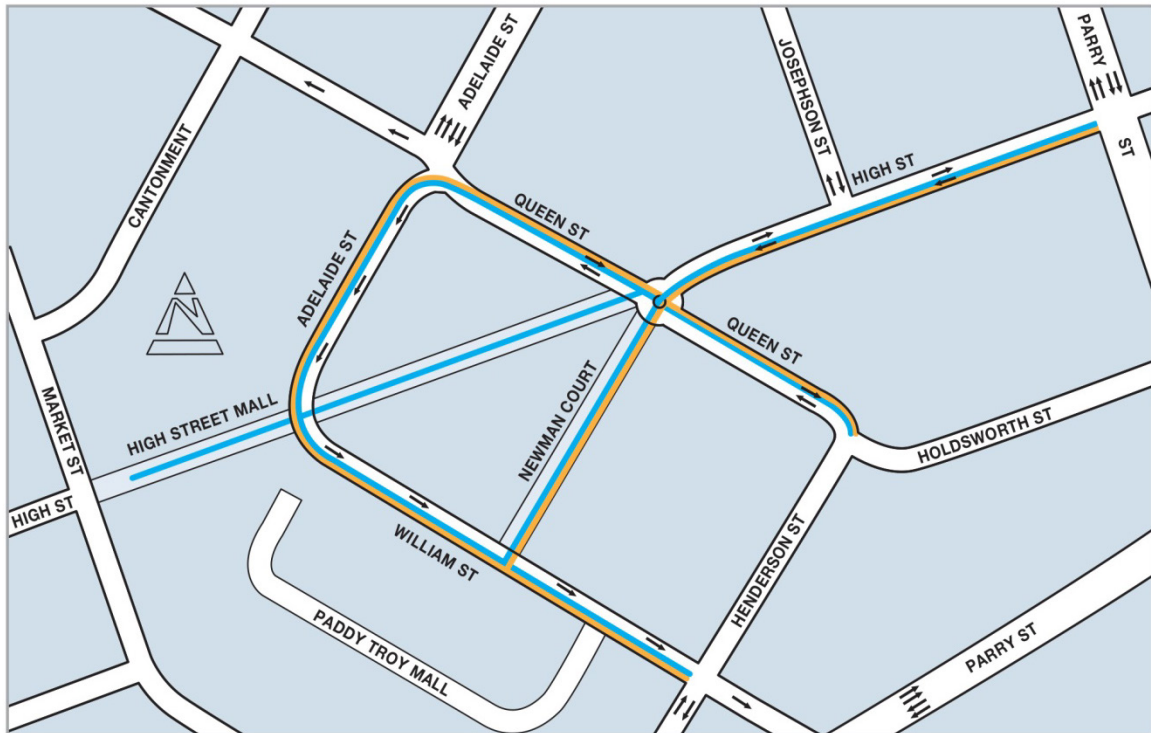


Natural Gas and Water Pipeline Works Fremantle – Kings Square

ATCO Gas Australia and the Water Corporation will be renewing gas and water mains in the streets surrounding Kings Square in Fremantle from April to June 2017.

Where will this be taking place?

New gas and water pipes will be installed on High Street, Queen Street, Adelaide Street, William Street and Newman Court. Water pipes will also be installed in the High Street Mall.

When will work start?

Construction is scheduled to commence in the week following Easter and is expected to be complete in June 2017.

Why are we doing this work?

Natural gas and water pipes in the area are nearing the end of their life – some more than 80 years old! This work will ensure the continued security and reliability of these services to your property for decades to come.

To minimise disruption, ATCO Gas Australia and Water Corporation have coordinated their project schedules to ensure the renewal works are carried out before the City of Fremantle commence their redevelopment works in the Kings Square area.

What impact will this work have?

Interruptions to supply

There may be minor interruptions to your natural gas and water services whilst we connect your property to the new main pipeline. If you are affected, we will notify you before this occurs and work with you to find a time that has the least amount of impact as possible.

Impact to traffic and pedestrians

ATCO Gas Australia and Water Corporation will use underground drilling techniques for this project wherever possible. This means the work can be carried out without the need to dig long trenches - greatly reducing the impact to pedestrians, road users and businesses in the area. Some minor excavation will still be required to get the pipes underground, and areas will be reinstated as soon as possible. We have also developed a Traffic Management Plan in consultation with the City of Fremantle to minimise disruption.

Noise

Construction can involve noisy work, including road cutting, excavating and compacting. We will do everything we can to reduce the noise of the works when operating close to business premises.

Property access

You will always have access to your property. There may be some minor diversions in and around the area if pipeline work is being completing in a section directly located at the front of your property.

Work times

Work will generally be carried out between 7am and 7pm on weekdays.
